This church has been here since 1831, so let's the beat keep going on as we grow and share Jesus Christ.

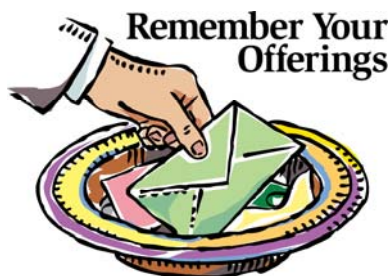
