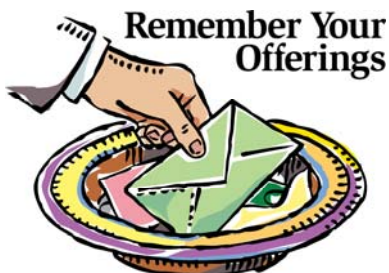
On Sunday May 12 we will also honor our Mothers during the morning Church service at 11:00.

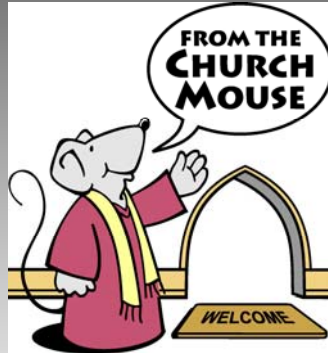
