The king stood by the pillar and renewed the covenant in the presence of the LORD—to follow the LORD and keep his commands, statutes and decrees with all his heart and all his soul, thus confirming the words of the covenant written in this book

The story of Josiah has always been one of my favorites.

At the age of Eight years old, he suddenly became King of Israel after his father was assassinated. When he was 16, he begins to seek out the true faith of Israel, and begins the task of rebuilding the Temple.

Israel has been an evil and corrupt nation, and has left the worship of Yahweh behind. God has sent a message through the prophets that Israel will be punished. The prophets said "This is what the LORD says: I am going to bring disaster on this place and its people."

While rebuilding the Temple, the Book of the Law is found. It is taken to Josiah and read to him. Josiah realized how evil the nation had become and how it had forsaken their God. He rends his garments.

Josiah then commands that all should gather at the steps of the Temple, and the book be read for all to hear. Then the King again renewed his promise to follow the Law, and all the people did as well.

This lead to the greatest Revival that Israel had ever seen. The temples to false Gods were destroyed and the Passover was celebrated. Suddenly, the God who had pledged destruction, instead brought peace and prosperity.

Beginning September 29 until October 2 we will have a Revival at Mount Zion. Services will be at 6:30 nightly. Rev. Tommy Artman, who is a wonderful Evangelistic pastor will be with us. I have known Tommy since I was in High School, and even






The United Methodist Men
