Scholarships available from First Presbyterian Church, High Point:

REUCHE and WILLARD KIMREY SCHOLARSHIP

The Christian Life Sunday School Class established the Reuche Chadwick Kimrey Scholarship Fund as a memorial to Reuche Kimrey, who was an active member of the class. It was additionally and sizably endowed by a bequest from the Willard Kimrey estate in 2001. The scholarship was also renamed during 2001 in recognition and remembrance of the love both had for First Presbyterian Church.

At the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, the income from the fund is to be used to make annual scholarships to high school graduating seniors who are active members of First Presbyterian Church and who will be entering the freshman year at an accredited two or four-year college or university.

Consideration will be given to financial need, but scholastic standing, participation in extra-curricular activities, and most especially, participation in the church program will be important. Recipients will need to be of good personal reputation and possess moral integrity.

SARAH and EARNEST MCCALL SCHOLARSHIP

The Sarah and Earnest McCall Scholarship Fund of First Presbyterian Church was established through a bequest from Earnest McCall in recognition of Sarah's lifelong contribution as a teacher and of their mutual love for education, for children and for their God and Lord.

At the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, income from the fund is to be used to provide undergraduate and graduate college scholarship assistance to worthy members of First Presbyterian Church.

Factors such as financial need, academic and leadership achievement and participation in the church program will be important. Recipients will need to be of good personal reputation and possess moral integrity. In addition, preference will be given to applicants who indicate the intent to pursue a teaching or ministerial career.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Applicants must submit a completed application form and, if the committee deems necessary, participate in an interview with members of the Scholarship Committee. The Scholarship Committee of First Presbyterian Church will select recipients. Application forms for these Scholarships are available from the church office.

Scholarships will be paid directly to the college or university selected by the student for credit to the tuition (or fees or other expenses billed by the institution) of the recipient. Scholarships will be made for only one year under this scholarship program.

RESTRICTION: Should an applicant for or a recipient of this scholarship be awarded a full scholarship to their chosen college or university, it is the responsibility of that person to notify the Scholarship Committee of such award. Since a scholarship is to be paid to the college only, acceptance of a full scholarship by the student would automatically void the payment of Scholarship dollars to the college or university.

The church office must receive the completed application form and all supporting documents by April 10th.
