The Montgomery County Baby Shop provides the basic needs of small children when there is a hardship for families and is a collaboration between St. Paul United Methodist Church of Christiansburg and Blacksburg Presbyterian Church. Families in Montgomery County and Radford City who have at least one child, have completed the application, and agree to meet the stipulations of the shop are eligible to shop at the Baby Shop once every two months after their application is approved. The shop is a donations-based project run and operated by community volunteers with ongoing support from area churches. We typically stock baby and toddler clothes up to size 5T as well as supplies needed by infants and toddlers, such as diapers, wipes, etc. Find out more about us at our website www.themcbs.org
