Frances and Cheryl (Co-coordinators) are happy to report that January 12-19, our first FP hosting of one family of 8 was very successful! They resided in the spacious Activities Room and, though they all got bad colds, the mom said how much she appreciated our help.

It required an amazing **33** people—all but two are MIPC folks, the other two were Theresa and Kevin Riley from Rockledge Presbyterian.

Family Promise asks us to do a guesstimate of how many hours it took for all 33 of us to take care of the family and it came to **378** hours. (This does not include the many hours Frances and Cheryl spent on meetings and planning.)

The important thing is that most or all of the 33 volunteers have said they enjoyed it and have expressed interest in helping when we host again, **September 28- October 5th**. Next time we will probably have two or three families so this first experience with just one family helped us work out some of the potential challenges.










Men's Bible Study Group with Milt Seapker
