PASTORAL MESSAGE!

Summertime has arrived. For United Methodists that also means that Annual Conference season is upon us; that means that some United Methodists are saying goodbye to their pastor and saying welcome to the community to pastors arriving. In Michigan, this year we add another layer to those changes as many churches find out they will be in new district arrangements. The Greater Detroit District will be larger and our partners in district ministry will expand on July 1 as Michigan Conference reduced the number of districts from seven to four. St Luke's will remain in the Greater Detroit District and the boundaries will expand to the north end of Oakland County and extend further west.

My appointment with you will continue. This will mark the start of my 23rd year of ministry in the Michigan Area, my 25th overall when adding my field education as a United Methodist Chaplain at The American University in Washington, DC. I enter my 11th appointive year as your pastor at St Luke's. June 8 also marks the 15th anniversary of my ordination in Grand Rapids as a Full Elder in the West Michigan Conference and The United Methodist Church. It has been a blessing serving the St Luke's community for this past decade and I look forward to the opportunities we may share in this year forward.

As we begin to look forward into the future, we do so with the guidance of the vision and mission of The United Methodist Church.

The Council of Bishops has invited us into the mission as the Church to "Love Boldly, Serve Joyfully, Lead Courageously" as we fulfill our calling and mission to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. To help us understand our call and mission, we will engage in study this summer, utilizing "*Knowing Who We Are, The Wesleyan Way of Grace*," by Lacey C. Warner; we will learn about Methodist beliefs, practice, and how our faith informs us to do what we do. We have an opportunity to look forward and vision where the St Luke community may move and act and do faith in the church on the hill and throughout the hills and valleys of our community.

Summer brings with it times for discernment, rest, adventure, connecting with friends and family, and preparing for new things in our life. Let us look at this summer as a canvass. You have an opportunity to sketch, to draw, to paint, to vision for the future. What picture would you paint? What path might you draw? Where are you in the sketch? And who are we missing in the work of visioning for the future?

Let us now march into the summer and all that is before us. Let us do so with bold love. Let us do so serving joyfully. And let us be courageous as we share the
