Jim Aaron found a guy with a 28 foot ladder to look at the bird access through the chimney vent. He couldn't reach the roof safely. Jim has found a 32 foot ladder and will ask him to come back. The two mobile shelvings were bought and assembled on the stage. The vestry approved Susan and Betty to evaluate the stage storage area and to throw out what isn't necessary.

New Business: May 21<sup>st</sup> after church is our mulch spreading date. We will ask Joelene if the youth can help. Two archway lights are out.
