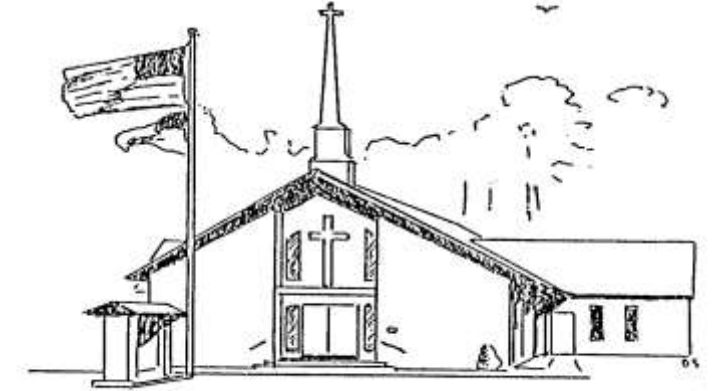
"Blue Wahoos" baseball game today. We will depart from LUMC at 3PM to attend the game. Hope to see you all here!
