"CELEBRATE RECOVERY PROGRAM" MINISTRY

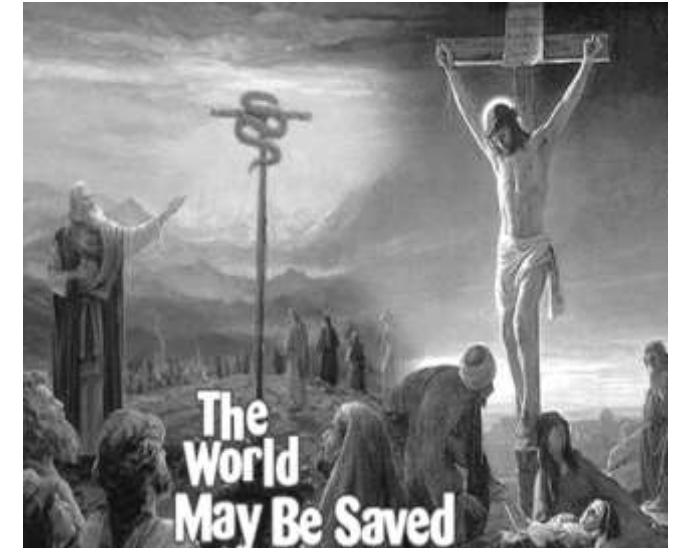

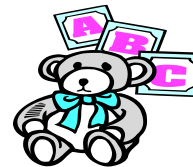
