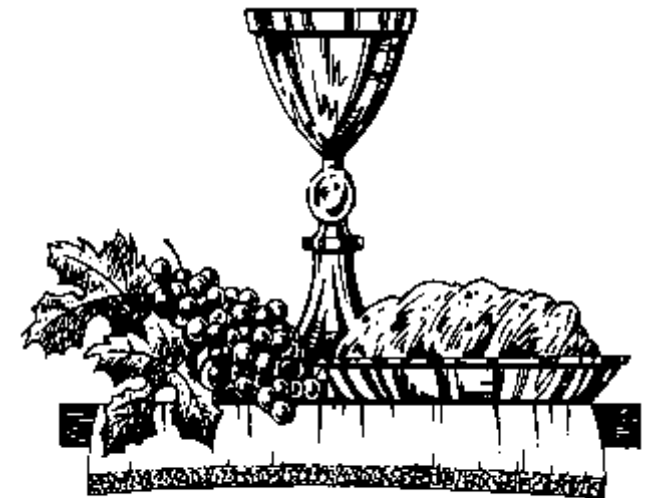
THANKSGIVING DAY DINNER
