July 22nd - Dr. Karl Stegall will be preaching the Word of the day and extending words of appreciation for our past and future support. He will also be available to answer any questions you have.

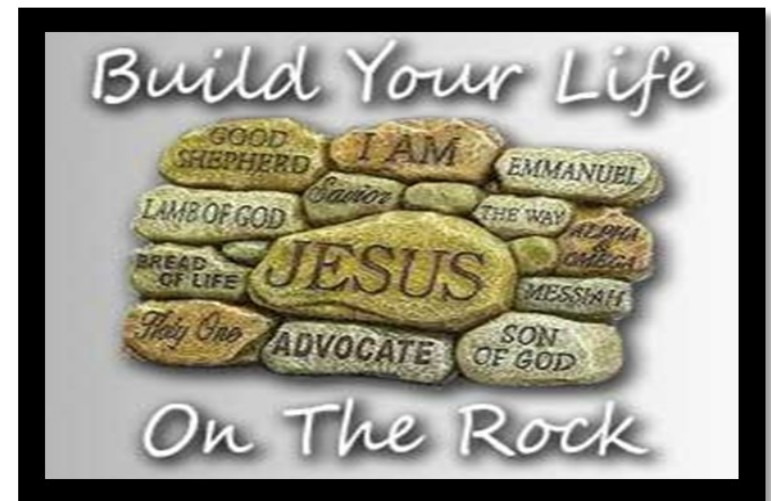


SECURITY CHECKS
