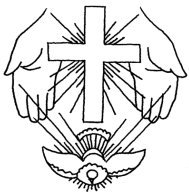

Divine Mercy Message: Today we commemorate Divine Mercy Sunday. It is important to review the meaning and historical significance of the day. On the Second Sunday of Easter of the Jubilee Year 2000, at the Mass for the Canonization of St. Faustina Kowalska, Pope Saint John Paul II declared the Sunday after Easter “Divine Mercy Sunday.” St. Faustina was a Polish nun who received visions from Jesus, including one of Jesus wearing a white garment with beams of red and white coming from His heart, which came to be known as the image of Divine Mercy. She wrote in her diary that Jesus said: “I want the Image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it...My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, especially poor sinners. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy.”

According to the vision, those who receive communion and attend confession on the Feast of Mercy receive total forgiveness of sins.

Though the messages are many, there are several new ways that God is calling us to a new form of devotion to the Divine Mercy. They are through meditation on the image of Divine Mercy; our participation in the Solemnity of Divine Mercy; the recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy; and honoring Jesus’ passion at the 3 o’clock hour. Let us recite always: *Jesus, I trust in You.*
