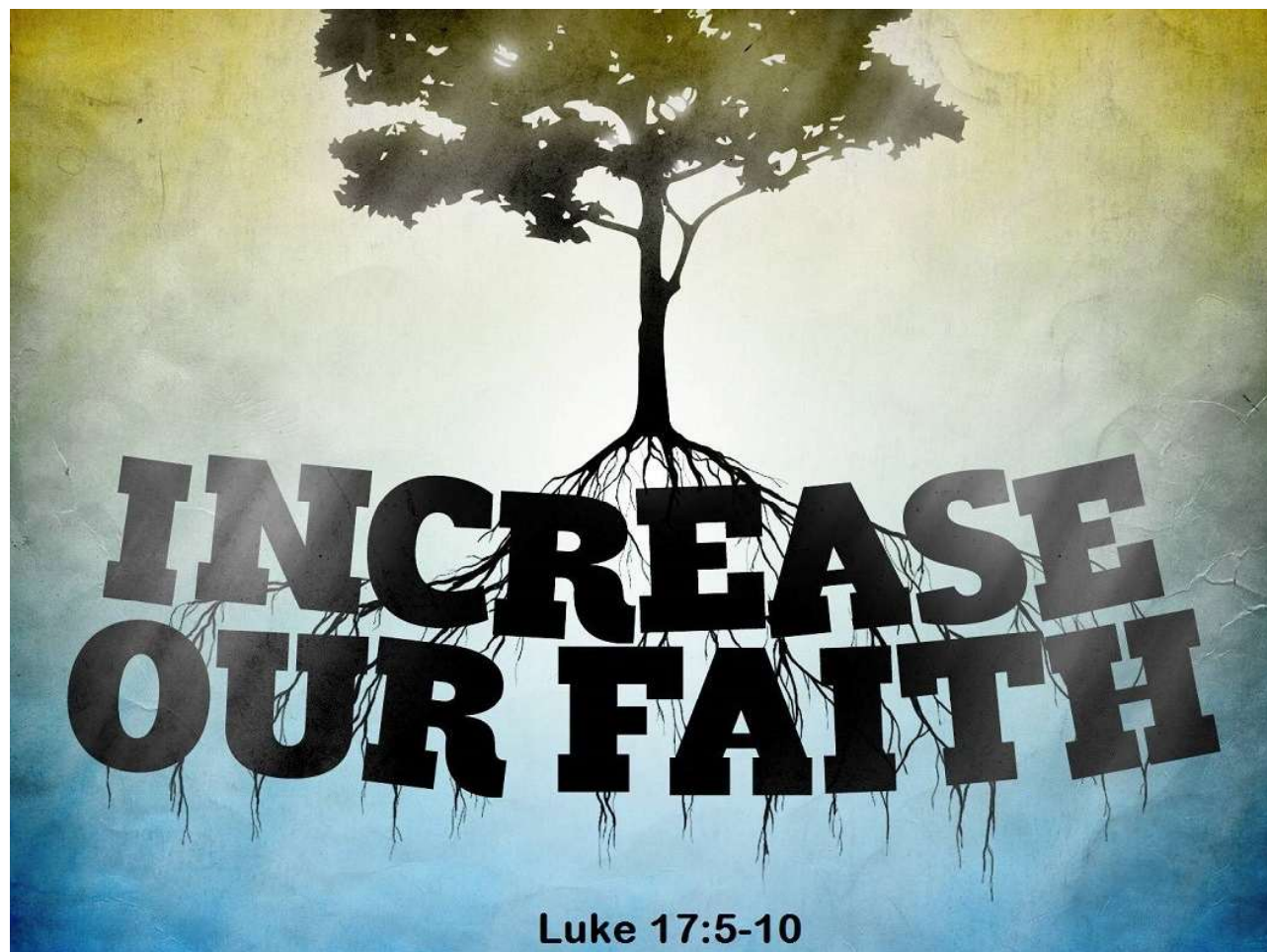

Lunch will be served; donations of baked goods are needed. We will begin setting up for the Bazaar on Monday, October 20th, at 6:00 PM.

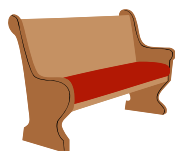
