to place an order.

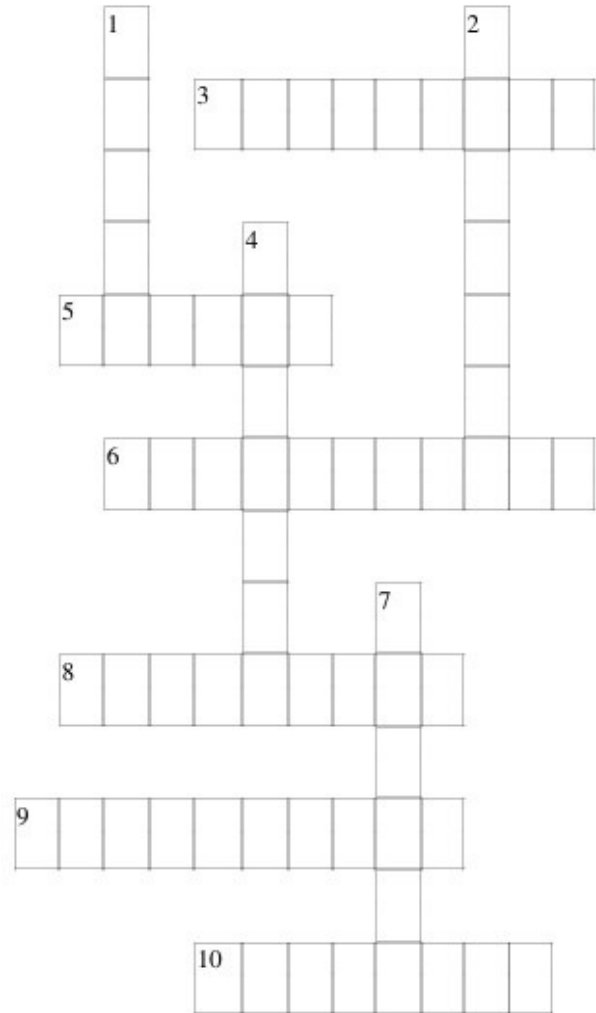


Ss. Peter & Paul Catholic Women's Club will
