

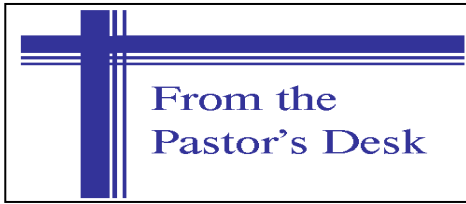

I recently heard from a church member who reminded me of a challenge I had made to the church a couple of years ago to read our Bibles daily for 15 minutes. Their words to me were, "I started off there and have increased it. I really enjoy reading and some of the plans I've done have helped me with the Old Testament."

I mention this because I am poor at following up on these challenges I make. It's not often I hear back from someone who has taken up a challenge and I get to hear how it has changed their life in some way. I found their words encouraging.

With that, I would like to extend the challenge to read 15 minutes every day again, but also add to it by encouraging you to memorize particular verses each week for 52 weeks, beginning on January 6, 2019.

We will text a new verse or verses to you each week beginning on December 31, 2018 and due to have committed to memory beginning on January 6, 2019.

The psalmist wrote, *"I have treasured your word in my heart that I may not sin against you"* (Psalm 119:11). As our country continues to move away from God, His word and His church, we must be prepared to both know and obey God's word.

I know I can be stubborn, shallow and scattered at times and I need the foundation and anchor of God's word to humble, stabilize and ground me.

The Bible makes a difference in our lives not only if we read it but put it into practice. Jesus closed the Sermon on the Mount with a parable. He told of two men, one who built his house upon the rock and the other built his house on the sand.

The man whose house was built on a solid foundation of rock was wise because his house stood when storms came upon it.

Jesus went on to make this comparison, *"Everyone who hears these words of mine and acts on them will be like (that) wise man who built his house upon the rock... because it's foundation is solid."*

I do want to wish Jan Lee Baptist Church a Happy New Year! I am excited by the opportunities and challenges we face together as the Body and Bride of Christ. In the coming year let's seek to bring the **peace** of God, the **passion** of Jesus, and the **power** of the Holy Spirit to our community as we fulfill the **purpose** of the Church.

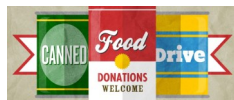
