We are so happy to have your child attend our AWANA Clubs at **First Baptist Church of Anguilla!** Club nights typically run from 5 – 7 p.m. on Sunday evenings.

An AWANA Club meeting consists of 3 parts: games, large group time, and handbook time (scripture memorization). More than 20 trained adults are involved in our clubs and programs. It is going to be exciting week after week to see children have fun while learning about God and memorizing His Word.

Your child will bring home an Entrance Booklet, which is the first step in AWANA achievement. We hope you will help your child complete this booklet in the next three weeks. After completing the Entrance Booklet, your child is eligible to earn more awards as a member of his or her AWANA club.

Each AWANA club is unique for a certain age group. They have their own uniform and handbook. If you can help us with the cost of these materials, it would be greatly appreciated. FBC Anguilla AWANA Club Rules

1. Clubbers must obey leaders at all times.
2. **Tennis shoes** must be worn at all times.
3. Entrance booklets must be completed to earn handbook and/or uniform.
4. Clubbers must be in uniform to receive awards and carry flags or Bible for pledges.
5. Clubbers are expected to participate in the entire club program unless a note is brought from home.
6. The AWANA 5-count and 3-count discipline system will be enforced.

AWANA Discipline System

5 Count: Used to quiet or bring to order an entire group. The person in charge initiates the 5-count by holding up their hand and fingers accordingly while counting slowly and loudly up to 5. **Other leaders silently hold up their hands and fingers.** By the count of 5, all clubbers and leaders are to be quiet and paying attention.

3 Count: Used when an individual clubber continues to misbehave.

Count of 1: Clubber that is misbehaving is given a warning.

Count of 2: Clubber is taken to another room and counseled by the Commander and his/her leader.

Count of 3: Clubber is taken to a separate area to remain for the rest of the club and parent is notified.

(The 3-count begins when a clubber enters church property.)
