A note from the Pastor:

Greetings in the name of Christ! I hope and pray your Wyoming summer is going great! I would like to encourage you with some thoughts in this brief note. In the following I will use the term Church several times and for the purpose of this article it refers not to the building or denomination but to the people who believe in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, The Church.

As Christians we are called to reach out to others inviting them to become Disciples/Christians and thus to become part of the Church.
