Let us begin with special thanks to everyone who has shared of their finances, gifts and talents here at the church. It is truly appreciated!

Have you noticed new carpeted runners in the Educational building and Fellowship Hall? Yes, they are there and were donated by one of our members. You know who you are, thank you!

We want to thank Tim Morgan and crew (Morgan Property Preservation) for the great job they did on the vinyl fence at the back of our property.

It is quite evident that our parking areas are in need of replacement. This is a major project and the Trustees have done a lot of work in putting this project together with a few other needed items. A few months ago we asked Shaun Arnoldi to do some site elevations and storm water comprehensive site plans. As we do this project, we are doing all we can to make it part of the comprehensive site plan and a long term solution at the same time.

Next, let's address the Parking Lot(s): We have requested and received authorization from the Administrative board to establish a special fund to receive donations for the funding of the Parking Lot Replacement. We have requested a fund of \$165,000 that we feel will cover the complete project cost. We will do a detailed project plan as we finish a few more details.
