Love

Greetings in the name of Jesus our Christ!

This week's Advent theme is Love. Read 1 Corinthians 13 and if your version uses the word charity, please know it should read love.

In this passage Paul tells us of three major themes, faith, hope, and love. In the final verse he shares that of the three only love will remain. In this passage, we have laid out by Paul, God's love and our call to love the same way. However, let's go back to love that never ends.

You see, in Christ, we have the living embodiment of God's love for us. A love that even death could not overcome. We are called to love God with all of our heart, mind, body, and soul. This is exemplified and lived out in the life of Jesus, even unto the cross! Jesus gave us a new commandment, "to love one another as He has loved us."

Love is the only human element, emotion, trait, nature, or however love could be described, that will survive death. When we decide to love someone they have no other choice concerning our loving them except to accept it or reject it. However, even if they do reject our love, our love does not end. The same is true of God's love for us. We can accept it or reject it, but we cannot stop His loving us!

So please, always remember you and I may be able to reject God's love, but we can never stop God loving us! Love truly came down at Christmas!

Readings for the Second Sunday of Advent, December 10, 2017; Isaiah 40:1-11; Psalm 85:1-2, 8-13: 2 Peter 3:8-15a; Mark 1:1-8



Second Sunday of Advent — December 10, 2017 LOVE

Reader: This is the second Sunday in Advent. Today, we light two purple candles. Last Sunday, we lit the candle of hope. This Sunday, we light the candle of love. One verse that many memorize and remember on this day is John 3:16, "God so loved the world..." Some people may not know the love of other people. That makes it harder for them to understand God's love. During Advent, we pray that we may remember again God's gift of Jesus to the world and know that God's love for all people is the reason for this gift.

(Light the first and second candles.)

Reader: When we look at the second candle, we remember God's love. When we read the words of Scripture, we know of God's greatness and care. We remember God's love at Advent when we remember that God sent Jesus to us to help us know that God is loving and just.

Reader: Read Isaiah 40:1-8.

Pray Together: Dear God: Thank you for your son, Jesus.
Thank you for the words found in our Bible that help us remember your love and care. Help us see how we can bring God's message to the people we meet in our schools, at our jobs, and in our neighborhoods. Help us be messengers of God's love for everyone. Amen.
