Readings for the Fifth Sunday after Pentecost, June 24, 2018; 1 Samuel 17:(1a, 4-11, 19-23), 32-49; Psalm 9:9-20; 2 Corinthians 6:1-13; Mark 4:35-41



Greetings, Grace, Peace and blessings in the name of Jesus!

Today is a busy day here at Rock Springs Church and is also a historical day as well.

Rock Springs Church (Methodist) was established in 1891.

On 24 June 1968 the current building was dedicated and officially became the new home of the congregation. It is quite interesting that very same year the Methodist Church merged with a couple other denominations and would change its name to United Methodist.

On this special day we have a lot happening and we want to be sure you know, member or not, that you are invited and encouraged to be part. Here is a brief list of what we have planned.

Live Sunday School at 9am

Worship at 10:30am

Meal and Birthday celebration in the Fellowship hall (Just like the first one in 1968)

Following the meal/celebration we move back to the sanctuary for a message Past, Present, Future

Following this we will resume our Holy conversation on A Way Forward for our church. In this time we will hear reports on this year's Historical Annual Conference. We will then enter our time of Holy Conversation continuing our reflections on the three questions from out last gathering:

#### Who are we as a Church?

The Church is not a denomination, a building, or some other world made up entity. The Church is a gathering of persons who have accepted Jesus as their Lord and savior, who are seeking to deepen their faith, who are called by God into service to fulfill the Great Commission found in Matthew 28. As people become saved, born again, redeemed they become part of the family of God. Each individual believer should hear and answer God's call on and in their life. We are part of something larger and bring our individualness and uniqueness to the body, the Church. One person a Church is not! Jesus did not teach or lead people to be lone rangers in their faith journey, but instead taught us how to live together in Christian love and unity. Paul gives the greatest teaching on this found in Romans 12:1-8. With this in mind let's move forward in Christian conversation. And just for clarification questions 2 and 3 are not the same as we will soon see.

#### **OUR WAY FORWARD**

### 1. What is God calling us too theologically?

What guides and informs what we here at RSFUMC believe? Wesley gives us a good starting point in his quad lateral. These four Primary is Scripture, tradition, reason, and experience.

## 2. What is or how is God calling us to ministry in Rock Springs?

What do we feel or sense God, through the Holy Spirit, that God is calling us to do or be involved in within our community? God is at work in the world and in Rock Springs! Where or what are areas of Christian need in our community?

#### 3. How will we, as a Church, move forward to follow and fulfill God's call for us as a Church here in Rock Springs?

In question 2 we should have identified some areas where we feel God calling us to be involved as a Church.

Now this question asks how will WE do it! See not the same question.

It is nice to talk about it, identify it, but the conversation needs to move to action!
