Readings for the Fourteenth Sunday after Pentecost, August 26, 2018: 1 Kings 8:(1,6, 10-11), 22-30, 41-43; Psalm 84; Ephesians 6:10-20; John 6:59-69



Greetings in the name of Jesus! Peace and blessings.

This from last week and where we begin this week.

Jesus died to pay the penalty for every sin large or small. Just because someone sins doesn't mean God loves them less. Remember "Jesus died for us while we were yet in our sins." So we come to the next situation and that is, if Jesus died for all sins and all we have to do is repent then why should we try to live a good life now?
