

Greetings in the name of Jesus! Peace and blessings!

I want to begin this message with a huge thank you from Karie and me for all your prayers and concerns for her and us following her foot surgery! It is so wonderful to feel the prayers and genuine concerns of our brothers and sisters.

As most of you already know she had Major foot surgery on Tuesday 4 September at Park City. It was indeed major foot surgery. She was in surgery for several hours and the Doctor actually spend about three and a half hours working on her foot. She has rheumatoid arthritis and it was severe in her left foot to the point of bone and joint deterioration and huge bunions. She was in constant pain. She had the bunions removed and they reconstructed the joints and bones in her mid-foot with screws, rods, and bone grafts (fusions). She has about 50 stiches in her foot and four in her left knee where they removed bone for the grafts. It will be six months of no weight bearing and then physical therapy. She is planning on going back to teaching soon and we would ask for continued prayers for healing and recovery.

Once again thank you all so very much for prayers and for those who have brought meals; it is a real blessing!
