Hello. My name is Tommy Plyler and I came to Guatemala from Pleasant Grove, Alabama in the United States. At home I work as an accountant for an electric power company. A part of why I have travelled to San Marcos is to work on a Church as a member of a construction team from First Baptist Church in Pleasant Grove. I understand that a portion of the Church was damaged by an earthquake. The construction team will remove the damaged portion of the building and use any of the remaining useful foundation to build a new section to allow new growth and better service to the Church and the surrounding community.

In a way the story of the damaged Church building is a lot like my recent life journey. I too experienced a personal life changing event when early last year my wife of 36 years passed away suddenly. **Mark13:33** Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is.

I have had to ask for help "what do I do now?" and "where do I go?" everything seemed so different. I was looking for a place where I could belong. LUKE 15:18 I will get up and go to my father, and I will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight. LUKE 15:20 So he got up and came to his father. As the construction team will do this week, I also have had to look at my life's foundation. 1 Corinthians 3:11 For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ. I have had to check my foundation and see if it is strong enough to weather the storms of life.
