



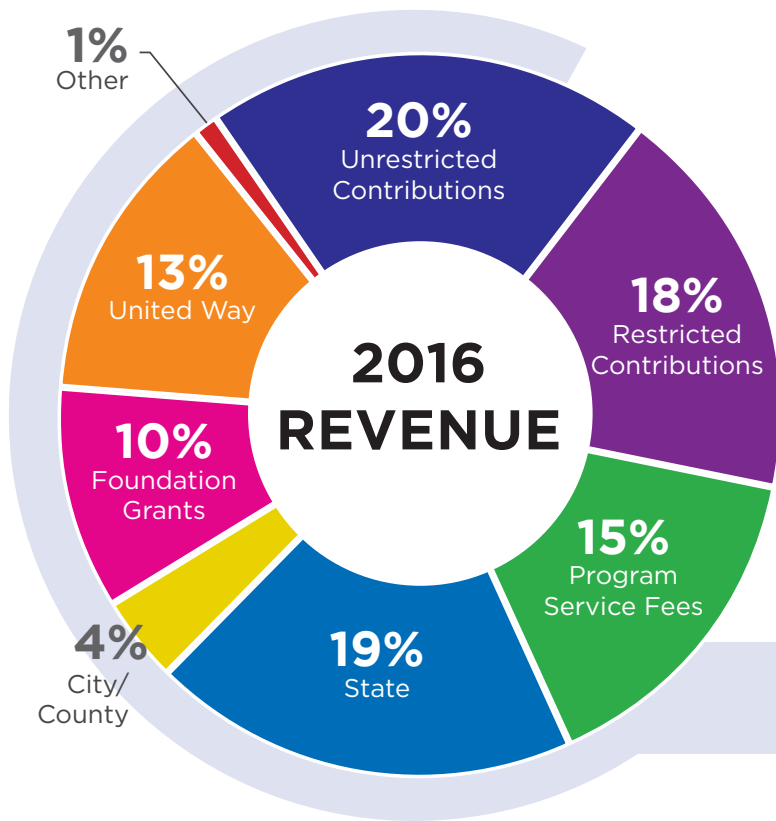
# Interfaith Ministries, Inc.

Long term prescription assistance for those without prescription assistance or those who have exceeded their Medicare Part D gap

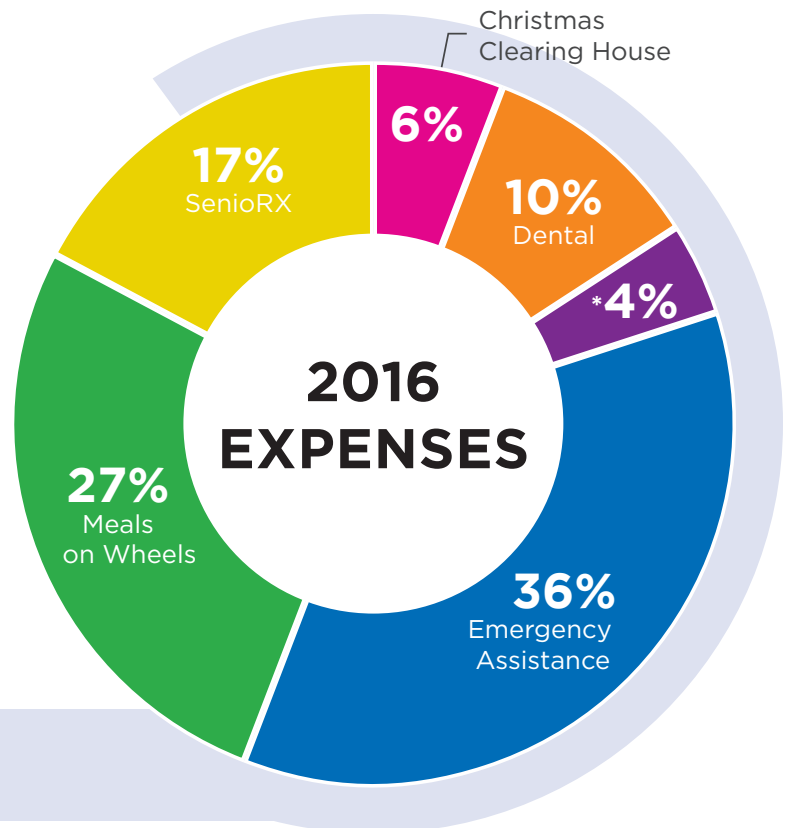
- Cooperative effort with East Alabama Planning Commission, local physicians, and pharmaceutical companies
