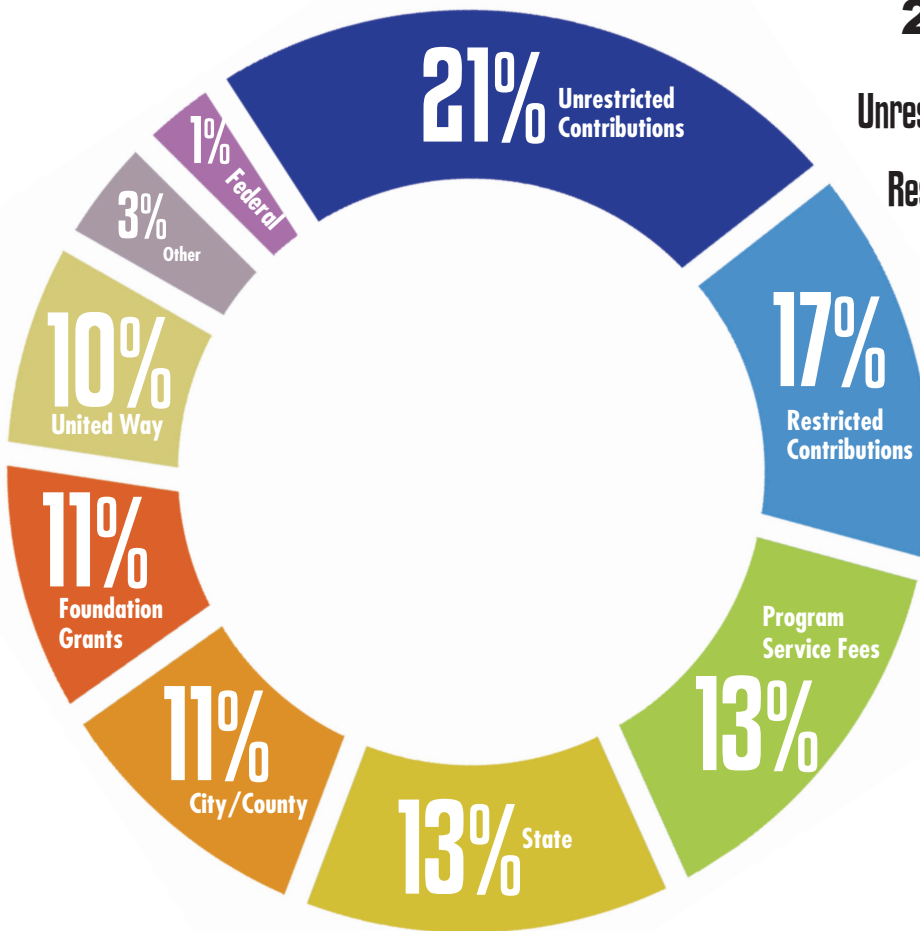


Bringing God's People Together To Serve God's People in Need

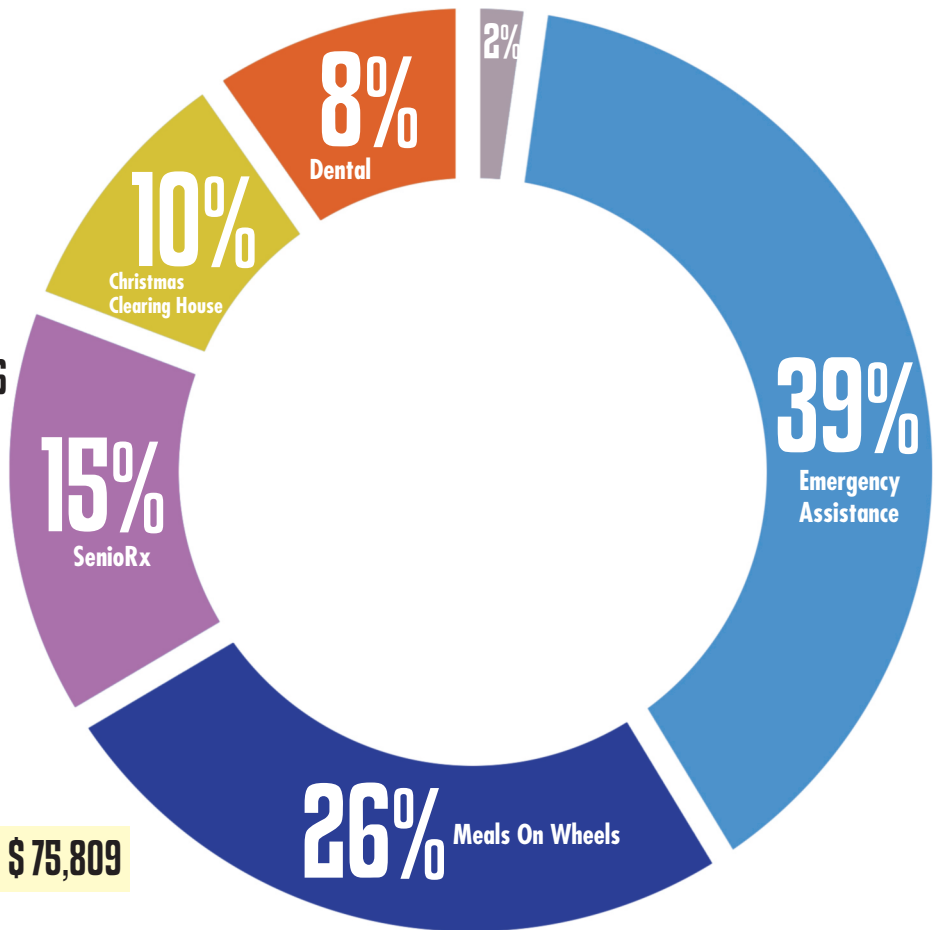
