Deacon Election Announcement

Date for Election—July 8 during the AM service

Section 4. Deacons

A. Ministry of the Deacon:

- Deacons** are to be servants of the church, in accordance with the meaning and the practice of the New Testament. The Deacons of the church are selected, not to honor the person, but to honor God and His church.
- Duties:** Their task is to serve with the Pastor and the Church Staff in performing pastoral ministries: proclaiming the gospel to believers and unbelievers, caring for church members and other persons in the community, leading the church to engage in worship, evangelism, discipleship, ministry and fellowship.

The deacons:

- Shall ensure the unity, harmony, and spiritual welfare of the entire membership under the direction of the Holy Spirit and in cooperation with the Pastor.
- Are to be personally concerned with reaching people for Christ and church membership.
- Are to assist the Pastor in the ministry of providing care for church members and other persons in the community.
- Shall assist the Pastor in the orderly and reverent observance of the ordinances of the church.
- Shall be faithful in their financial support of the church.
- Shall be actively involved in the ministries of the church and regular in Sunday School and worship attendance.
- Shall attend Deacons' meetings. If a deacon is absent from three consecutive deacons' meetings or six meetings during the year, without justifiable reason as determined by the deacon body, he shall be considered out of fellowship with the deacon body.

B. Qualifications:

1 **Scriptural Qualifications** for serving as a deacon are found in Acts 6:3-5 and 1 Timothy 3:8-13. Church members should study these passages, prayerfully seeking the leadership and the direction of the Holy Spirit in discerning the scriptural qualifications.

2. Practical Qualifications:

- Aged 24 or older, having been a member of this church for at least 24 months on the date of the election.
- Faithful in attendance and participation in the services and programs of the church, being present in Sunday School at least 50% of the time.
- A scriptural giver, bringing his tithe regularly to the church for the Lord's work.
- Evangelistic and missionary in spirit, deeply interested in the salvation of souls at home and abroad.
- A man who restrains from destructive criticism of his church and is cooperative in advancing the work of the church.
- Has the ability, along with his wife and family, to hold in confidence all matters that should not be told or discussed with parties not involved.
- Subscribes to our church doctrine and is in agreement with our polity, policies and programs as set forth in our church documents.
- In agreement with the church's cooperation with outside bodies like the Coosa River Baptist Association, the Alabama Baptist State Convention, and the Southern Baptist Convention.
