Greetings Members & Friends of ENUMC! Merry Christmas. Hard to believe we have actually survived 2017. It has been a long and exciting year here in Naples, and all around the country. But as you are addressing your Christmas cards, and finishing up your shopping lists, please prayerfully consider your end -of-year giving to East Naples United Methodist church.

Financially, our income is far behind our expenses for the year. As of the end of October, we are behind by \$68,334, and if we project that out for the final 2 months, by year end, we are going be in the red by \$82,000. With your help, we can make up this deficit!

Add to that, the large unbudgeted expenses that we have to pay this year. As you know, Hurricane Irma caused significant damage to our buildings. Roof damage alone is going to coast us over \$20,000, and add to that the repairs in Fellowship Hall and the offices. These costs are going to be quite high. And before you ask, our insurance deductible is extremely high, so we will have to pay for these repairs on our own. If you wish to help with these expenses, your tax deductible donations can be made out to the church, and designate it for Building Repair.

As you look around the sanctuary, you will see our wonderful new stain glass windows. Thanks to some hard working church elves, they were protected from Irma and came through without a scratch. Good thing too, because we still owe over \$30,000. While the roof is our primary concern, if you would like to help pay for some of these windows, please contact the church office about donating. You can even get your name placed on a window if desired (and with an appropriate donation). We also are selling Bricks to help cover the cost of the windows, and the remodeling we did this year to Elsey Hall.

As I had mentioned, all of your gives are Tax deductible. Also consider gifts other than cash. Donations of stocks can be a huge benefit to both you and the church. This could help you avoid some capital gains if you have held the stock for a long time, and you can deduct the full value of the stake. Please give me a call about donating stocks, real estate, or any other tangible items.
