Electronic Giving Options

We are excited to announce new ways of electronic giving through our church website and mobile phone app! It's easy, fast and secure. Below are the step by step instructions for each method of giving. Once you're set up it's as easy as step 5 every time!

Website Giving:

- 1. Go to your web browser and type in <u>www.enaples.org</u>
- 2. Click the Online Giving tab near the top of the screen
- 3. Click the green Give Now button at the bottom of the screen
- 4. Follow the on-screen instructions
- For future giving, if you set up an account – Follow steps 1-3 then log in with your email and password, select amount and fund then click process.

Mobile Phone Giving:

- 1. Go to the App Store or Google Play and search for Give Plus Church, Click on the app to install it
- Open the app from your main phone screen, It will ask you "Allow Give+ to access this device's location?" Click Allow
- 3. Click "Find Churches Near Me" and select our church from the list OR you can type in our zip code 34112 or East Naples United Methodist Church and Click Search. Once you see the church listed, tap it to open
- 4. Follow the on-screen instructions
- 5. For future giving open the app, select fund and amount, click next, confirm payment.
