PASTOR'S NOTE – JUNE 2018

United Methodists from all over West Virginia and Garrett County, Maryland will be gathering from June 7th through the 10th in Buckhannon to worship, celebrate, discern, decide, ordain, and appoint as we conference together. Please be in prayer for our conference and for the United Methodist Church in general as we will be considering some important matters this year:

Our health insurance program is at this point in financial trouble as the payouts for health needs are exceeding funds. The conference insurance committee has developed some proposed changes that will greatly affect those covered by our insurance (I am covered by Becky's insurance and so you do not provide insurance for me). Changes proposed by the insurance committee would not increase premiums to the church or raise apportionments but will instead raise deductibles, no longer cover spouses if they have insurance available at their place of employment, increase the number of hours worked to qualify for insurance coverage, and greatly raise the out of pocket expense for prescriptions. If the proposed changes are not adopted by the conference, then the costs would then have to be passed on in premium and apportionment increases.

The Way Forward Commission has presented its recommendation to the Council of Bishops of three possible plans to present to the General Conference in 2019 for how the church may deal with proposed changes to our Discipline around the issues of ordaining homosexuals and permitting same-sex marriages in our churches and by our pastors. These proposals will be shared at Annual Conference and as you can imagine there will be some emotional conversation.

Mary Leighton and I will be representing Kenova UM Church and we ask that you keep us, and the Annual Conference lifted up in prayer.
