On Easter Sunday morning, before the 8:33 am worship service the plan is to 'flower' the cross. Here is the plan: The church will provide enough lilies for the sanctuary on Easter Sunday. Church members will be encouraged to make donations to purchase carnations (in a variety of colors) to 'flower' the outside cross. We are asking for a minimum of \$5.00 (five dollars) donation. (Obviously if you want to donate in excess of \$5 that would be welcome). The donations will be used to purchase the carnations and hopefully serve as a fundraiser for Relay for Life. Forms for donations will be in the bulletin for this Sunday (March 11) and next (March 18). Donations in memory of or in honor of loved ones will still be listed in the Easter bulletin.
