We need shepherds for children's ministry during Sunday School. If you are available to serve, please see Pastor Casey.

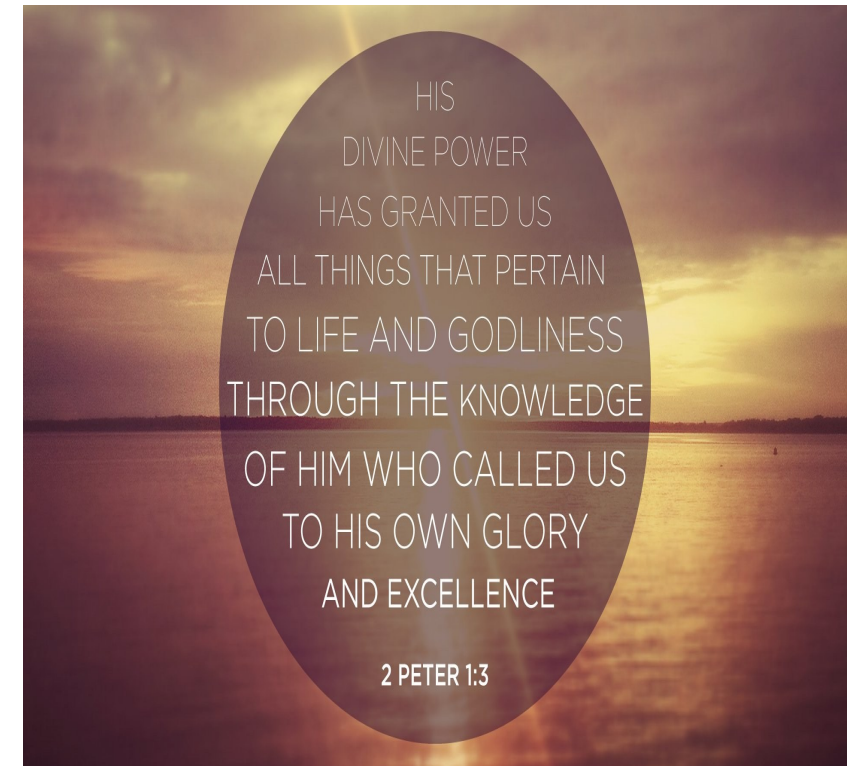
Please join us on Wednesday evenings at 6:30 for Bible studies for all ages. There is a free meal for children and youth at 6:00.
