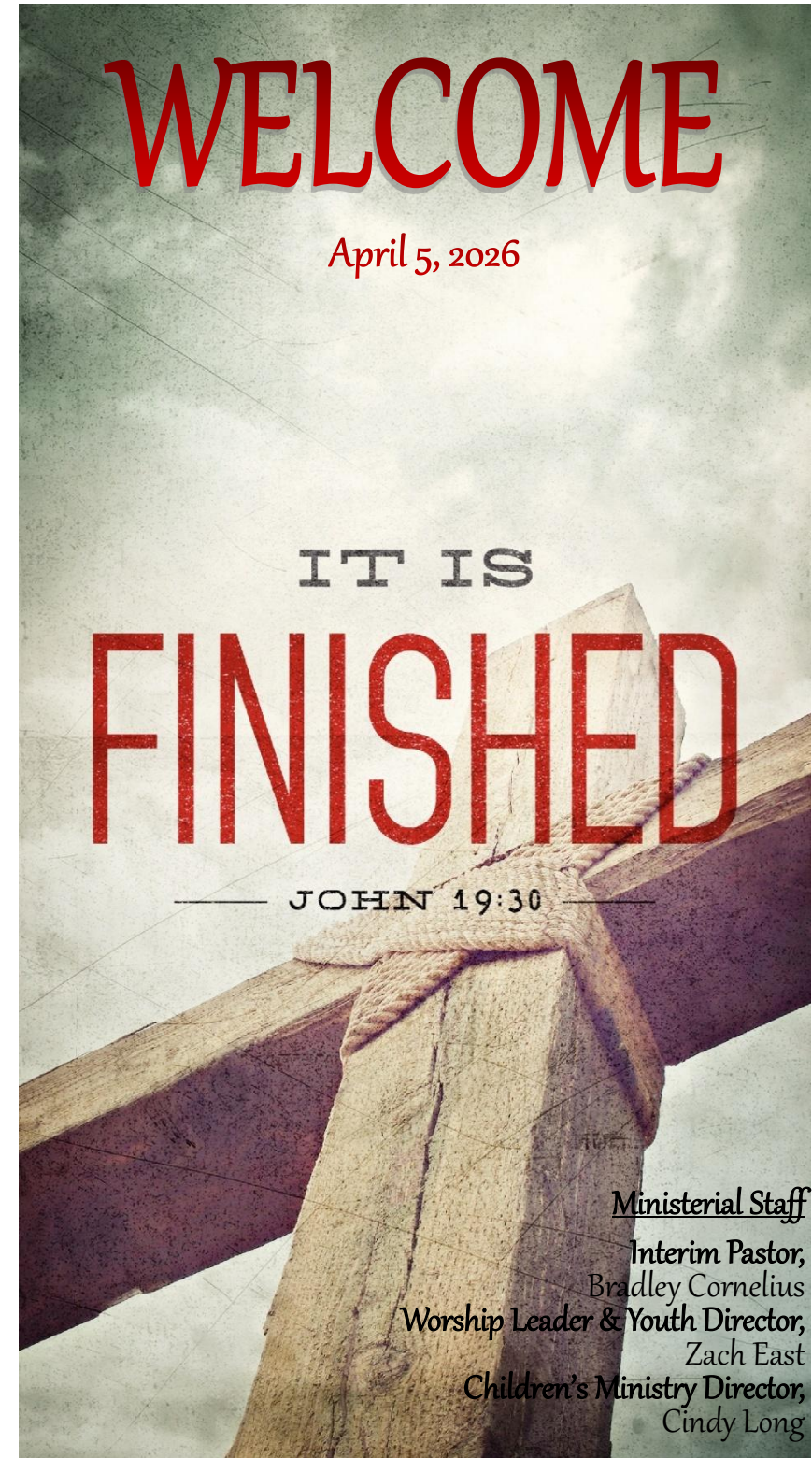
This week's prayer for our Pastor Search Committee :
