Please help us obtain some items!

The Mission, Outreach and Evangelism Committee invites the Holy Trinity family to help us obtain inexpensive household and personal care items. They will be packaged, 3-4 items per gift, to honor mothers and grandmothers in the five indigenous villages supported by Tools for Development during its existence. In conjunction with Immanuel Presbyterian Church of Monterrey, Mexico, the gifts will be distributed during a weekend of festivities and healthcare activities in mid-July.

On May 13 and May 20, and again on June 10 and June 17, we will be collecting the following:

- Acrylic or melamine plates, glasses, pitchers, bowls. These MUST be non-breakable. Three-four plates or glasses will be considered a set.
- Shawls large and sturdy enough to 'backpack' a baby
- Decorative tote bags and decorative metal tins
- Two yards of solid color, sturdy cotton fabric for the women to make into skirts
- Small sewing kits with a variety of colors of thread
- Large bottles of inexpensive, nicely scented shampoo
- Bath soap – a package of 6-8 bars will provide 3-4 gifts
- Hairbrushes suitable for thick, long hair
- Umbrellas

PLEASE NOTE THAT WE CANNOT USE OTHER ITEMS AT THIS TIME.

Items should be in good condition, but, other than soap, shampoo and hairbrushes, by no means do they need to be new. Goodwill stores, Thrift Town, resale shops, Salvation Army stores and dollar stores are great sources!
