MURIEL HENDERSON HEALTH UPDATE

Terry and Muriel Henderson served as Missionaries to Mexico for over 35 years with the Give Ye Them To Eat Program (GYTTE). They retired as missionaries a few years ago and moved from Mexico to the Dallas, Texas area where they currently reside. Tabernacle has supported the GYTTE program and the Henderson's the entire time they served in Mexico. We still continue to support GYTTE monetarily and through Mission trips to Mexico (six so far). Muriel has had a number of medical challenges the past several years including a bout with cancer. In February of this year, while on a visit to Phoenix, Arizona, Muriel had a bad fall, broke her left femur, and broke her elbow. She required a cast on her arm and had to have a rod inserted in her femur. After spending time in the hospital in Phoenix, she was moved to a rehab facility for physical therapy. For the last three and a half months, she has been busy with physical therapy at two facilities and with home care (she arrived back home in April). The therapists were eventually able to get her up and moving. After progressing through a variety of mobility devices, she is now able to use a walker for short distances. As of a June 13th note from Muriel, her orthopedic doctor told her that even though it takes a full year to recuperate from these types of breaks and surgery, the new bone will build up on her femur and elbow. He considers her ahead of the norm. Muriel thanks everyone for their loving concern and prayers. Terry and Muriel's home address is 400 E. 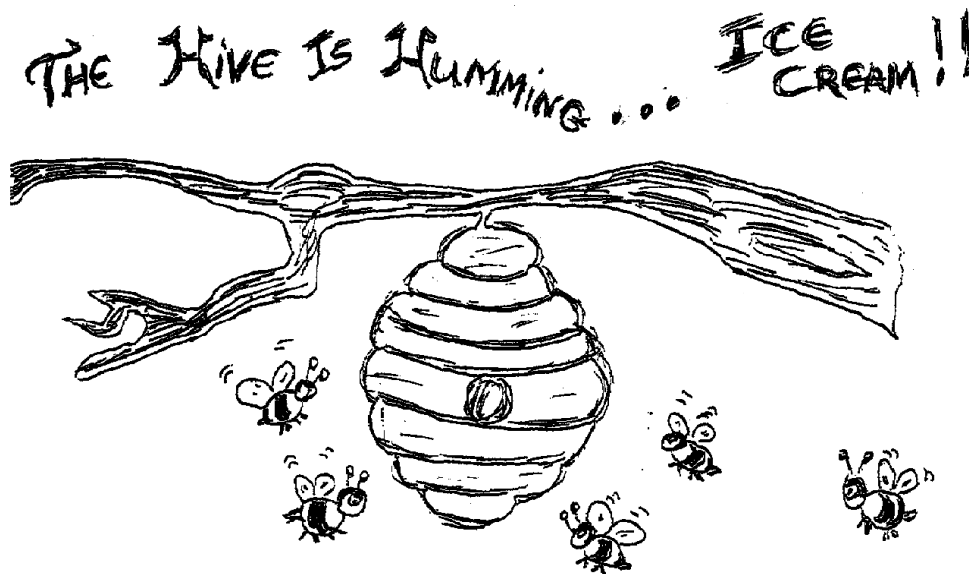

In addition to the food distribution they helped: 41 families to keep their electric connected, 7 families from having their water shut off, 7 families from being evicted, 3 families from having gas service to their home terminated, 35 families with clothing and 5 individuals with medications.


SCHOOL DRESSING DAYS
