- Parents will be called to pick up their teen if the teen leaves the building for any reason and/or acts in a manner deemed unacceptable by the Youth Ministries Leaders and/or parent chaperones.
- Parents MUST sign kids in upon arrival and sign kids out in the morning at dismissal.
- Drop off & pick up will be in the basement of the church. The lock-in is in the church.

# LOCK-IN RULES & GUIDELINES

1. All youth must sign this sheet, indicating their agreement to these rules.
2. No one is allowed to attend the lock-in without a signed parental permission slip and contact numbers.
3. During the lock-in, all youth must remain within the church. Lock-in participants will not be allowed to go outside of church or venue without adult supervision.
4. No insults or gossip.
5. Use your body respectfully: No revealing clothing, no PDA, no chasing, throwing, or hurting others.
6. Keep it clean: no swearing.
7. Cell phones permitted with restricted use.
8. Special medication or required items should be given to the Chaperones.
9. No illegal drugs, alcohol, dangerous materials, or firearms.
10. All lock-in participants must respect others physical boundaries. Inappropriate behavior (i.e. Physical intimacy or sexual harassment) is not permitted and will NOT be TOLERATED!
11. Same sex sleeping quarters will be provided. Lights out/quiet hours will be observed in these areas.
12. It is expected that all lock-in participants (youth and adults) will participate in the program.
13. Take care of yourself and clean up after yourself.
14. Be considerate and respectful of other participants and leaders.
15. Be respectful of the church and property of the church.
16. Violation of these rules will result in disciplinary action and may include the participant being asked to leave the lock-in. Parents will be called to pick them up regardless of the hour.
17. The first infraction will result in a verbal warning. Repeated violations will result in calling the parent to pick the youth up.
18. THE ENFORCEMENT OF THESE LOCK-IN RULES IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY.

11:30-12:30	Breakfast at Midnight! – Late night snack of breakfast food!
12:30-2:30	Small Group games – kids can break into small groups and play games of their choosing.
2:30-6:30am	Quiet time – there will be four rooms (two for boys, two for girls). One room for each will be a sleeping room (phone allowed, but headphones must be worn and screen darkened). One room for each will be playing movies and phones are allowed. Students must be quiet, but do not have to sleep.
6:30am-7:00am	Wake Up Worship Service
7am-7:30am	Juice, Milk, and Donuts – kids will be packing up, eating donuts, and ready for parents to pick up no later than 7:30am!
