

Countryside Kids in Praise!

Today's Kids in Praise lesson is that JESUS USES HIS POWER TO HELP US! We're going to learn about when Jesus prayed for his disciples and all those who believe in Him.

(Parents, don't feel obligated to do all these activities. We want to provide you with many options to worship with your kids on their level. Do what works for your family!)

- Show your kid(s) a power tool and the corresponding manual tool (ex: a drill with screwdriver bit & a screwdriver, an electric mixer & spoon, etc.) Demonstrate how the power version and manual version work (ex: screwing in a screw, beating an egg, etc.) – BE SAFE! Talk how the task is different using the power and manual tools. We as people have strength and are able to do things (like the manual tools), but Jesus has real power that is much stronger (like the power tool). He can do things we can't, and He uses his power to help us!
- Read Mark 5:21 – 24, 35-43 with your kid(s).
- Talk about Jesus' power. Doctors can help people when they are sick, but Jesus even healed this girl after all the people thought she had already died. His power is more than human power, and he uses that power to help us!
- Act out the story using Playdoh creations (it can be simple – Playdoh people can just be balls of dough).
- Form Playdoh into a power tool shape (or anything else powerful) to help remember that Jesus is powerful!
