Talk About It

Prepare: Gather some materials you will need for our time of worship today: a bible, a notebook, pen or pencil, communion supplies (juice and bread), family or friends that are quarantined with you.

Pray: Ask God to calm your mind and to help you to hear and understand what He is trying to teach you today.

Read: Philippians Chapter 1 verses 1-18, have someone read this scripture out loud, or take turns reading it a few verses at a time.

Pause: Take a deep breath. Think of all of the people you are thankful for. Take time to name some of them. Think of the people whose faith prepared the way for you to trust in Christ. How might you prepare the way for others? Paul was in prison because of his faith, yet he became more courageous and fearless. How are you becoming more courageous and fearless during our current Pandemic?

Read: What verses stand out to you and why? Read it again if you need to!

Pray: God let us continue to be courageous and faithful throughout these changes in our world. Let us be joyful always in the Hope that you give. AMEN

Praise: Have the youngest person in the group share something they are thankful for.

Take communion remembering how truly thankful we are for Christ's body and blood given for us. Listen to some worshipful music and sing!
