FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"It's a New Year (or will be by the time you get this) and things are going to be different this year!" This is the cry of hope. What will the next twelve months bring? We don't know, so hope is all we have at this point.

There are some guarantees. This is an election year for most congressional members. If the recent election of Alabama is any indication, we are in for a sickening ride as party politics fight for control.

It looks like our government will continue a military presence in Afghanistan. Although with the defeat (and I use that term with hesitation) of ISIS, we can reduce our presence in Iraq and Syria. However, don't look for a lessening in the Middle East conflicts. With the recent proclamation by President Trump recognizing Jerusalem as the capital of Israel, which the Palestinians want as their own, the tension just increased.

Economists recently made a faith-based (Read Hebrews 11:1-2 about faith) statement saying that the economy will remain strong through 2018 with the stock market continuing its strong showing. I call such a projection "wishful thinking". They can't make a guarantee on this or at least one I trust, but I am hoping they are correct.

Sadly, we can put on the guarantee list more shootings and terrorist attacks. Why do people who want to end their own lives, such as the man in the Las Vegas, Nevada shooting, want to destroy others in the process? And although there is the declaration of the defeat of ISIS, law enforcement people the world over expect ISIS-inspired terrorist attacks to continue.

And there is always the unexpected. I keep hoping the unexpected is something good and not the other way around. It is part of our nature, I'm thinking. Even the most pessimistic people among us seem to have in their DNA at least one optimistic gene. I credit this scientific possibility for my hopefulness that good things happen in unexpected ways in each of our lives.

There are steps we can take to help in some directions. The usual New Year's Resolutions for exercise and weight loss are going to be there. Plans for a strong devotional life with prayer are certainly a good thing. I'm encouraging the use of "The One Year Bible" as a way of reading through the Bible with me in 2018. Another positive move - better management of our time and our resources. Organizing areas of our lives provides a path for gaining focus on what matters to us personally. We don't always have to go with the flow. We can take charge of many areas in our lives and guarantee some positives.

Although I think about having control over my personal life throughout the year, it becomes more important to me as a New Year begins. I know our God is great and is totally in control.

For the month of November, 2017, the Church Budget received \$4,102.34 more than it spent. For the year, the Church Budget received \$5,595.01 more than it spent.

Major Maintenance & Repair Fund – this designated money will be used to pay for major maintenance or repair projects to the Church building, parsonage or parking lot. The Board of Trustees must recommend all expenditures from this fund to the Church Council, and the Church Council must approve all expenditures from this fund. This is a perpetual fund and a minimum balance of \$2,500.00 shall be maintained at all times.
