

**ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL MEETING
ROSCOE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH
NOVEMBER 15, 2018**

The Administrative Council of Roscoe United Methodist Church met November 15, 2018 in the church fellowship hall with Mike Baker presiding. Pastor Dale opened with prayer.

Minutes: The minutes of the October 18, 2018 meeting were read. Beth Nelson moved and Tom Barcroft seconded a motion to accept the minutes as presented. The motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: In Debbie's absence, Pastor Dale reported a balance of \$75,898.73 in the checking account and \$390,505.23 overall balance as of October 31st. Cindy Fry moved and Linda Weber seconded a motion to accept the treasurer's report. The motion passed.

Finance: Jeff Poland reported that five \$10,000.00 CDs were purchased at Home Loan.

SPR: Beccy Porteus reported that the committee has not met since the last board meeting.

Youth: Susie Stout reported the lock in was attended by 12 youth during which they filled 14 shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child and they painted pumpkins. There are 2 new youth attending Sunday school. They are looking into going to an OSU hockey game in December and Youth Jam in January.

Discipleship: Cindy Fry reported pizza pals will be changing to Friday evenings. Rehearsals continue for the Christmas program. There is a possibility of a new Beth Moore study beginning in the spring.

UMW: Beth Nelson reported the women will be meeting Saturday, November 17th.

UMM: Pastor Dale reported in Michael's absence. The monthly meetings are on hold due to low attendance. County wide men's meetings continue at Edie Ryan's. Apple Butter Stirin' parking brought in approximately \$1200.00. Money was donated to pizza pals along with several other area organizations.

Missions: Mike Baker reported that 89 shoeboxes were filled for Operation Christmas Child. Children's Services will be giving children's names to us for the Christmas project with a deadline of December 9th for the gifts to be at the church. December 15th is the Angel Tree luncheon and invitations were sent to 13 children.

Care Team: No report.

Worship: Beth Nelson reported hanging of the Greens will be November 25th after 10:30 service. All of the spots for the lighting of the advent wreath have been filled except for the late Christmas Eve service.

Music: Les Widder reported 270 tickets have been sold for the Signature Sound concert with all remaining tickets available at the door. Meals and logistic details for the 25th have been arranged. The Christmas Cantata will be December 16th and rehearsals continue. The Brentwood UMC Youth Chorale will be coming for concerts on July 13 and 14, 2019. They will be staying overnight at Coshocton Village Inn and Suites. We will need to provide supper Saturday and lunch Sunday.

Trustees: Tom Barcroft reported that the shelter post repair job has been awarded to Hathaway Construction. They will have it done by year end. Pastor Dale and Tom completed a walk through of the building with representatives from the Sheriff's Department. Recommendations made were: Change hardware on Sunday school room doors to lock from inside, purchase door stops so doors can't be pushed in, lock all doors including front doors after 10:30 service begins, cameras for entrance doors especially the one by the office. They were not in favor of concealed carry because if they would be called to the church for a problem they would not know if the person(s) with a gun is one of us or an intruder. They offered to complete ALICE training if we would like. There is a broken window at the parsonage which will be fixed. Beth is getting estimates for the men's room refurbishing and the floor trim

in the fellowship hall. Mike is taking care of leaf disposal and will get the lift to repair the light in the gym. Mike and Dale will put away the picnic tables at the shelter. Red Cross will be using the gym for blood drives beginning in 2019.

Pastor: Pastor Dale reported a new Bible study about how we got the Bible begins December 4th with Tuesday morning and Wednesday evening times.

Old Business: None

New Business: Mike Baker reported Alexa Norris would like to come speak to Sunday school classes on December 16th about H2O. Mike will talk to classes to see if they would like to combine that Sunday. Notes from the follow-up session with Mark McDaniel were distributed and discussed.

Adjournment: Les Widder moved and Beth Nelson seconded a motion to adjourn. Motion passed.
