

**ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL MEETING  
ROSCOE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH  
JANUARY 17, 2019**

The Administrative Council of Roscoe United Methodist Church met January 17, 2019 in the church fellowship hall with Chad Miller presiding. Pastor Dale opened with prayer.

**Minutes:** The minutes of the November 15, 2018 meeting were read. Amy McCoy moved and Susie Stout seconded a motion to accept the minutes as presented. The motion passed.

**Treasurer's Report:** Debbie Werner reported a balance of \$72,004.04 in the checking account and \$384,634.97 overall balance as of December 31st. Connie Hoffman moved and Les Widder seconded a motion to accept the treasurer's report. The motion passed.

**Finance:** No report.

**SPR:** Beccy Porteus reported that the committee has not met since the last board meeting.

**Youth:** Susie Stout reported the youth are planning to go to Winter Jam Saturday, January 19<sup>th</sup> but tickets have not been ordered yet due to possible hazardous weather conditions.

**Discipleship:** No report.

**UMW:** Judy Fesler reported nothing new.

**UMM:** Pastor Dale reported in Michael's absence that the monthly countywide men's breakfast is cancelled due to Edie Ryan's restaurant being closed temporarily.

**Missions:** Pastor Dale reported on behalf of Judy Martin that 25 children were served through the Children's Services Christmas gift project, the Angel Tree event was attended by 18, and the 52 Days for Girls kits completed by RUMC were delivered on December 28<sup>th</sup>. A total of \$9,300.00 was disbursed at year end for various mission projects.

**Care Team:** Connie Hoffman reported that the card care team averages mailing around 50 cards per month. The Visitation team of 9 members visited 30 different individuals in 2018 and made 106 actual visits.

**Worship:** Bee Lehner reported the altar signifying Jesus' baptism will remain for one more Sunday, then it's back to green until Lent begins in March

**Music:** Les Widder reported approximately 330 people were in attendance for the EHSS concert. The Christmas Cantata went well with 40 people involved. RUMC has been asked to host the Malone University Chorale on March 2 and 3 as they travel through our area in route to Zanesville. We would need to provide overnight housing on March 2 and lunch after services on March 3. They would sing during services and possibly hold an afternoon concert. Les Widder moved and Susie Stout seconded a motion to host the chorale. Motion passed.

**Trustees:** Pastor Dale reported that the posts at the shelter have been repaired. LoneStar is coming to complete an inspection of the building on January 28<sup>th</sup>. Our insurance company did a walk through of the facilities and would like something other than grass under the playground. They also requested that the church have insurance waivers from outside groups which are using the building. Les suggested that alternate lighting be looked into for the altar area as what is there now shines in the eyes of the choir members. Bee mentioned that the outside door handle at the office hallway is loose.

**Pastor:** Pastor Dale reported nothing new.

**Old Business:** None

**New Business:** Pastor Dale asked on behalf of Mike Baker if there was interest in attending an MLB game again this summer either to Cleveland or Pittsburgh. The overwhelming choice of the members in attendance was to return to Cleveland again.

**Adjournment:** Les Widder moved and Judy Fesler seconded a motion to adjourn. Motion passed.
