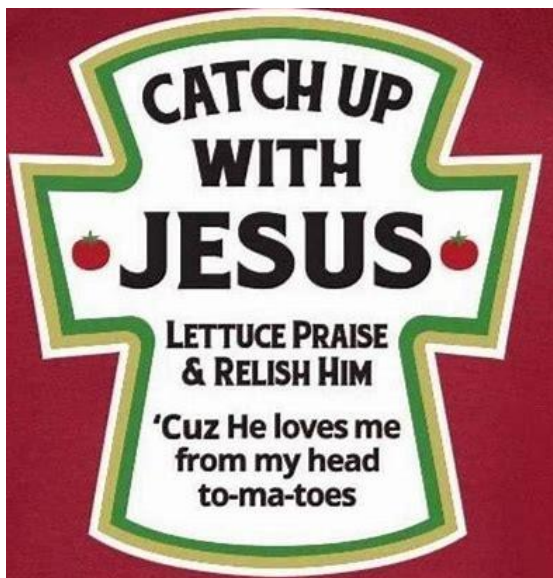
**Communion** will be offered on **Sunday, September 2 and every Wednesday @ 7 PM.** All are welcome to come to the table.
