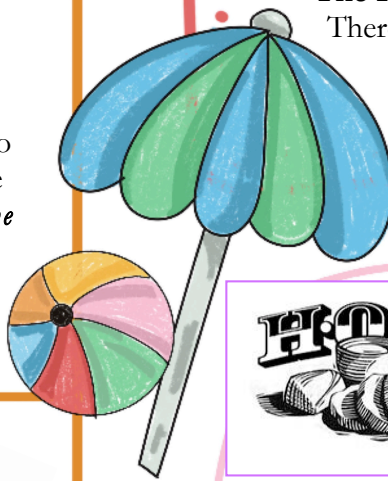
Coffee Hour

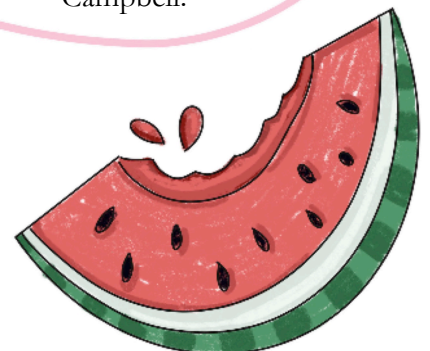
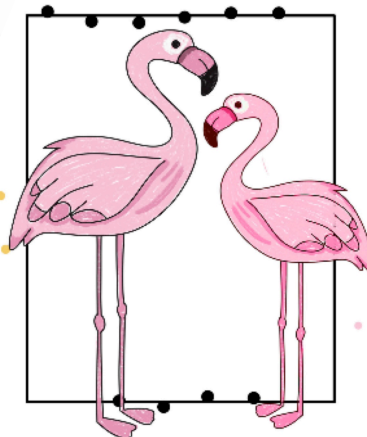
