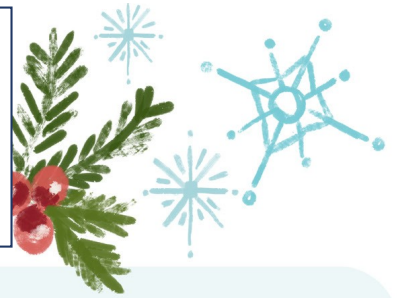

Sunday, January 11 11:30 am Potluck Today

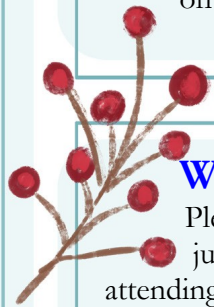
You are invited to enjoy a potluck meal after the second service today. If you don't have a dish to pass – no worries – we have enough food for all who choose to attend.
