Hudson United Methodist Church is a polling site for the City of Hudson.

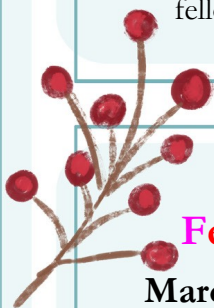

On Tuesday, February 17 the Sanctuary Singers will be gathering in the lower level at 7 pm. If you are unable to attend, please contact LeAnn Stein.

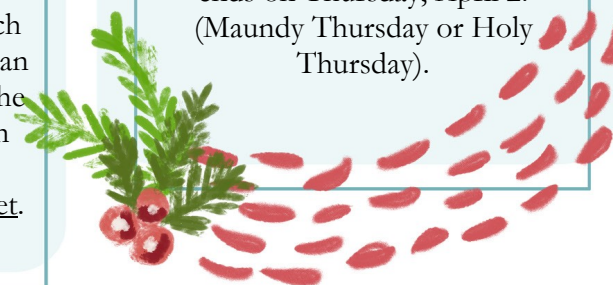

We will be celebrating the first day of Lent with a **7 pm** Ash Wednesday service.

This is a service of scripture, hymn, prayer, repentance, reflection, and disposition of ashes. The ashes are made from the palm branches of the previous year's Palm Sunday and are applied to the foreheads or the back of the hand signifying repentance.

Lent begins February 18 and ends on Thursday, April 2. (Maundy Thursday or Holy Thursday).
