Liturgist: Let us worship.

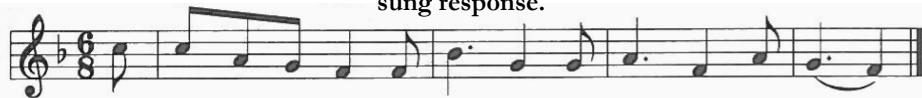
