The Greatest Story Ever Told

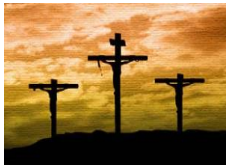

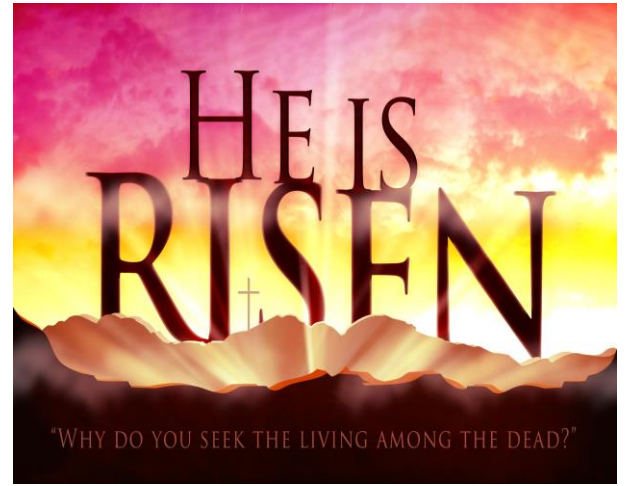
What do you believe...and why?
