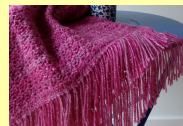

## Living the Questions Sunday School Class

The Living the Questions Class has begun discussing Queering Lent, a book of 41 poems and one sermon, by Slat's Toole. As Slat's mother, Kathy Toole says, "one of our challenges is to listen to the voices of the disenfranchised. The book "queering lent" was written by one who identifies as the "Q" - queer/trans/nonbinary - in the complex of LGBTQIA+ identification. It grew out of poems written for each day of Lent in 2017 as a personal spiritual discipline. These poems of [Slat's Toole](#) give voice to woundedness while living in their deep faith in the expansive ground of God's love."

An exploration of queerness and Christianity--and the queerness of Christianity. This collection contains references to transphobia, violence against trans people, mental illness, and suicide. Tithes from the royalties will go towards organizations that support queer/trans people in the church.
