Too hurried to help?

Luke 10:30-37

"But a Samaritan on his journey came up to him, and when he saw the man, he had compassion. He went over to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on olive oil and wine. Then he put him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him"(vv.33-34).

How tied are you to your calendar or to-do lists? What has God been trying to teach you here?

Are you aware of a need your family is facing right now that needs your strong presence?

We are inspired by the heroic acts of those who come across a need and stop everything to help. It's not only an inspiration, but also a mandate as Christ-followers. But the greatest hindrance to a heroic response to crisis is the idolatry of personal agendas and to-do lists. It's not only a scribe or priest issue. It's an issue for all of us. Our agendas give us a strong case of nearsightedness. We must ask the Holy Spirit to put compassion lenses over our eyes so that we can see the needs we would otherwise miss because of our schedules.

A pastor of a large church noticed his wife at the door of his office. She needed to talk, but the pastor just didn't have the time. The wife said, "There's a prominent member of your congregation whose marriage is in trouble, and she needs a few minutes of your time." Suddenly concerned, he said to her, "Well, that's different, I have time for that." The wife tearfully said, "It's me." Sometimes the victim on the side of the road isn't just another stranger. It might

even be your wife or your child. We look long enough to see their needs, yet we still walk by on the other side of the road.

Are you present and available to your family and to others? Or do you live in a fish bowl of your own achievements and agendas? Slow down. Ask questions. Listen to the voices of the people in need around you. Ask God to give you laser vision and understanding, so you won't play the wrong role in the story of the Good Samaritan.

Pray: Ask the Holy Spirit to give you eyes to see the needs that you might otherwise ignore or look past.
