Classes and Schedules

Parent's Morning Out operates as closely to the Ashe County Schools calendar as possible. In addition, the inclement weather schedule will run closely to Ashe County Schools inclement weather policy. Our year begins at the end of August and runs through mid-May. The school day is from 9:00 to 12:00. The children bring their own lunch and a healthy snack will be provided by PMO (crackers, fruit, vegetables, etc) for mid-morning.

Class Options and Enrollment

-Twos (age two August 27) 8 children on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays

-Threes and Fours (age three or four by August 27) 12 children on Mondays, Wednesday and Thursdays

Admission and Fees

To register your child, please complete the registration form posted at www.wjumc.net and mail it with \$50 non-refundable registration fee plus tuition for May 2019 to WJUMC (address listed above). Please put attention to Parent's Morning Out program. Admission will be given priority to Ashe County residents. Preference is also given to individuals who complete registration early.

Two year old Class - Tuition \$190/month per child

Three year old and Four year old Class - Tuition \$175/month per child

Curriculum

There will be weekly and monthly themes to teach age appropriate skills and Christian values will be incorporated daily. Our mission is to minister to families in our community by providing a safe and nurturing environment where children may grow physically, socially, intellectually, emotionally and spiritually. Our teachers will nurture all of these goals by offering developmentally appropriate activities and experiences.

Lead Teachers and Assistants

All lead teachers and assistants will be held to high standards. Lead teachers must have at least an associates' degree in education, experiences working with young children, CPR and First Aid certified, and a successful background check. Assistants must have a high school diploma, experiences working with young children, CPR and First Aid certified and a successful background check.

Each class will have one lead teacher and one assistant.

Three and Four year olds must be potty trained.
